The school is a comfortable, loving place for children to grow and develop. The unique program provides hands-on opportunities, balanced to include teacher-directed, and children chosen activities. By participating actively in their learning, children take pride in their work and gain confidence. They acquire questioning, reasoning and experimenting skills, language and literacy, large and fine motor skills and most importantly a life-long love of learning.



Curriculum

LFNS offers a clearly articulated integrated sequential curriculum based on the developmental stages of children and the New York State Educational Standards for Pre-Kindergarten. It is designed to develop every young child's love for learning and academic readiness, and includes

language, reading and writing readiness, mathematics, science, art, French, singing, dramatic play and physical education. The school promotes active learning by means of hands-on experiences and projects. Project work involves focusing on a specific topic that is meaningful and enjoyed by the children, and discovering as much as possible about that topic. Children benefit from an outdoor/gymnastics time daily.



Dedicated Teachers

The principal and the head teacher are certified and experienced early childhood educators. They hold Master's degrees in early childhood education. Their love for teaching shines through in every interaction with our children. The principal is a licensed New York State School Administrator and Supervisor and School District Administrator with over twenty years experience in leading and developing independent schools in New York.



Beautiful Campus

The campus is safe and serene. The new fenced-in playground features the best quality of soft-tiles and early childhood equipment. The classrooms are spacious, bright and newly equipped. They are organized into working centers which provide children with an opportunity to make choices, work independently and collaboratively. Furnishings and materials are age appropriate and allow for open-ended exploration and play. Parking is available for drop-off and pick-up.

LFNS offers a nurturing, structured and well-balanced half-day or full day programs for 2.9 to 5 year old children. Children are challenged to reach their fullest potential.
